Tournament Rules

1. This is a non-sanctioned tournament. The following rules plus USBC Rules and Regulations will govern all participants in this tournament.
2. This is a doubles/alibi format tournament. Doubles will consist of any combination. An alibi is bowling with another person during a prepaid entry for an additional fee and bowling score count for the tournament. Multiple partners are allowed but can only cash once with the same partner.
3. The entry fee is \$60.00 per doubles with a ratio of 1:10 and \$20 alibi with a ratio 1:15. The breakdown of the entry fee will consist of \$30.00 for prize fund and \$30.00 for lineage and expenses. 100% of all prize fund collected from either doubles and/or alibis will be returned to all bowlers. Money will be distributed one hour after the last squad of the tournament unless a protest is pending.
4. Entry fee must be paid in full prior to bowling. No refunds on entries exception see rule # 8. Entries close at the last scheduled squad time printed on the tournament entry form. Alibis will be collected prior to the start of each shift.
5. Handicap shall be based on 80% of 210 men and women. Entrants will use their highest USBC sanctioned league averaged based on a minimum of 21 games or more for the 2015-2016 season. If no average last year, you may use your highest average of the 2015/2016 season 21 games or more as of Aug. 06, 2016 (Verified). All others will bowl scratch. The ten-pin rule is not in effect. The max entering handicap shall be 54 pins per game for women; for the men, 54 pins per game.
6. It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of his or her average. Failure to use proper average or make corrections up to the completion of the first game shall disqualify score if the submitted average is higher than the actual. Prize-winnings will be based on the higher submitted average. See Rule 319A
7. All bowlers are subject to re-rating in accordance with USBC rule 319. The tournament official reserves the right to re-rate any bowler whose entering average does not reflect the bowler's true capability. See Rule 319E
8. **AVERAGE ADJUSTMENT:** The tournament manager has the right to adjust or reject any entry without penalty prior to the time of bowling. If a bowler doesn't accept the assigned average, the entry fee will be refunded.
9. In accordance with USBC rule 18 the use of abrasives on the surface of bowling ball during tournament play will result in disqualification.
10. In accordance with rule 12 the application of any foreign substances on any part of the approach that detracts from the possibility of other players having normal conditions is prohibited. This includes but not limited to such substances as talcum powder, pumice and resin on shoes and soft rubber sole's and/or heels that rub off on the approach.
11. Any participant who has won \$600.00 or more in any event or tournament during the previous 12 months must report actual scores, position, and amount won to Tournament Office prior to bowling.
12. The tournament directors reserve the right to accept or reject any or all entries and decide on all questions and/or disputes. The decisions of the tournament directors shall be final.
13. The tournament directors may add additional squads Saturday.
14. All squads bowlers shall bowl three games.
15. **Cash Only, No Checks, and No Tabs.**
16. Non-compliance with any one or more of the aforementioned rules, non-disclosure or misrepresentation to tournament officials constitutes complete and final disqualification for any and all parties for non-complying and non-disclosing.
17. Any challenge made by a participant against the tournament and/or officials that results in any kind of legal action, that participant hereby agrees to pay all reasonable attorney fees incurred should the tournament/official prevail in defense of said challenge.
18. Entry fee shall be \$10.00 for Singles scratch or handicap event. (\$8.00 prize fund and \$2.00 expense). Prize fund shall be returned 100% to bowlers. The ratio is 1:15.
19. No non bowler can be in the pit when the tournament is going on.
20. Premature termination of the tournament brought about by war, national emergency or emergency cause relating thereto or there from, fire, natural disaster or any other reason beyond the control of the "Thunder Bowl" shall cause, to the extent required thereby, all advertised prizes, guaranteed or otherwise, to be prorated in accordance with the number of entrants who have bowled in each of the respective events up to the time of such termination.
